

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION  
SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting held on Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, the Queensbury Town Board adopted a Resolution approving the extension of the Queensbury Consolidated Water District to establish the Jenkinsville Water District in accordance with Article 12-A of New York Town Law. The Resolution is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Article 7 and Section 209-e of the New York Town Law. An abstract of the Resolution is as follows: The Town Board made the following determinations relating to the proposed establishment of the Jenkinsville Water District: (a) the notice of public hearing was published and posted as required by law and is otherwise sufficient; (b) all of the property and property owners within the proposed Jenkinsville Water District will be benefited thereby; (c) all of the property and property owners benefited are included within the boundaries of the proposed Jenkinsville Water District; and (d) the establishment of the Jenkinsville Water District as described in the Resolution is in the public interest. The Board approved the establishment of the Jenkinsville Water District as the boundaries are set forth in the Map, Plan and Report and resolved that the proposed Jenkinsville Water District improvements as set forth in the Map, Plan and Report may be constructed by the Town upon certain conditions including, without limitation, obtaining New York State Comptroller's Office Consent.

A full copy of the Resolution is on file in the Town Clerk's Office at the Town Hall, 742 Bay Road, Queensbury, New York, and can be examined by any Town elector during normal business hours.
